Agreement to look at this next time round, acknowledging the attendance was up on previous years which made it a longer night. Next time will look at attendee numbers and adjust accordingly.
- Phil welcomed new teams and just asked all captains and their teams to be patient with scorers, acknowledging some are more efficient than others and for some this can be daunting for some of the newer players. Simon acknowledged this request and suggested it extend to all new teams as they get familiar with each venue and set up.
