General Business.

- Phil made comment in relation to President's report referring to low number at District Championship with 8 of the 12 teams not having a player in attendance and Captains need to play a role on gathering interest and promoting. Phil stated he felt putting the onus/blame on Captains was unfair with teams members having family and other commitments. Simon responded that 5 months heads up was given and this should be ample of time for players to arrange things
